Cookies

A cookie is a small text file which is placed onto your device (e.g. computer, smartphone or other electronic device) when you use our website. We use cookies on our website. These help us recognise you and your device and store information about your preferences and past actions. Other cookies are essential for the smooth running of the website.

For example, we may monitor how many times you visit our website, the pages you visit, traffic data, location data and the originating domain name of your internet service provider. This information helps us to build a profile of our users and improve our services. Some of this data will be aggregated or statistical, which means that we will not be able to identify you individually.

Facebook	_fbp	Used to identify browsers for the purposes of providing advertising and site analytics services (Facebook)
HotJar	_hj*	Used by the HotJar analytics <u>HotJar Cookie</u> Information
Cookie Control	CookieControl	This records your cookie preferences so only the cookies you've accepted are added.
Google Remarketing	DSID, IDE	Used to identify browsers to provide advertising, including to show ads to past visitors as they browse sites and apps on the Google Display Network and for site analytics.
